





FROM TRAUMA TO TRIUMPH

Adi, or Albert, fled from the Democratic Republic of the Congo when he found out that he had a target on his back. His crime? He had publicly criticised the government and someone had told on him. His words were used against him, his house was seized and he faced a lengthy prison term.

He sent his wife and children to stay with family, and the night before he had to surrender, he got into the back of a truck to start a 5-month journey to safety and reunion with his family. Now they are reunited in the Bronx, and Adi is learning English so that he can support his family rebuilding their lives.

I love my classes, my English is so much better than before, I feel free...



In 2022, our supporters helped raise nearly \$24,000 in funds that went 100% towards programming for over 1,500 students and 49 volunteer teachers, administrators, and classroom assistants.
